 - At home
 - Over lunch or coffee
 - In the community

MD 301

Training for Forming Disciple-Makers and Equipping Apostles

Leaders are trained to:

- train “Ananias”—those who spiritually accompany others at the parish and in the world
- lead small discipleship groups
- lead others through the Called & Gifted discernment process as:
 - gifts interviewers
 - small group facilitators
- lead a parish team in discerning a discipleship pathway

Those who successfully complete all three parts will be certified as Ananias Trainers as well as to conduct Called & Gifted gifts interviews and lead Called & Gifted small groups.

Prerequisites:

- completion of MD 101 and 201;
- read *Forming Intentional Disciples*, *Fruitful Discipleship* and other materials on the reading list;
- completion of parts one and two of the Called & Gifted discernment process (workshop and gifts interview)

Please note: this is an intensive training designed for those who are involved in the work of evangelization and disciple-making in their parish, diocese or apostolate. The content presumes you have a working knowledge of the information found in *Forming Intentional Disciples*, *Fruitful Discipleship* and significant field experience.
